The 2015 Oklahoma World Language Teacher of the Year, the 2016 SWCOLT Regional Teacher of the Year, and candidate for the 2017 ACTFL Teacher of the Year, Darcy Pippins is a National Board Certified Teacher with a Master's degree in Education from the University of Oklahoma. In 20 years, she has taught all levels of Spanish, currently teaching Spanish III, IV and AP Spanish Language and Culture at Normal High School. She started the Elementary Spanish Mentor program in 2014 where students from her advanced classes have the opportunity to teach Spanish at five feeder schools in her district. This program won the ACTFL Global Engagement Initiative Award in 2017. This year, 43 of her AP students participate in this program, impacting the learning of over 450 elementary students and acting as advocates of world language education. Darcy presents at the state, regional and national levels. She strongly believes that accomplished teachers should not work in isolation and could imagine teaching without the support of her professional learning community.
