## SCHOOLS CLOSED THROUGH APRIL 3RD

### Grab N Go Meal Program Begins March 24, 2020

The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) has approved a waiver for serving combined breakfast and lunches during the suspension of school through at least April 3<sup>rd</sup>. This action was recommended by Governor Gordon, Superintendent Balow, and approved by the Board of Education on March 16, 2020. This service will focus on students who qualify for free and reduced meals, however, ACSD #1 will make this program available for all students and children under 18 through the USDA waiver obtained by the WDE.

Each Grab N Go Meal will have breakfast and lunch items for a student. Grab N Go meals will be distributed from **11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.** at the following locations:

**Parents picking up the Grab N Go meals for their students will be required to either have the students with them, the student's ID, a Student Z Pass for transportation or give food service staff their students name in order to get the sack lunch for their students that day.**

**Beginning Tuesday, March 24<sup>th</sup> from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., one (1) combined meal per student will be made available each week day.** To help ensure enough Grab N Go sack meals are prepared at each site, parents with students who receive free and reduced meals can click the [link to this form](#). Please indicate the number of children/students needing meals and the location where you will pick up the meals. This program will run Tuesday, March 24<sup>th</sup> through Friday, March 27<sup>th</sup> and Monday March 30<sup>th</sup> through Friday, April 3<sup>rd</sup>.
