Dear ACSD#1 Families:

Welcome back from Spring Break. This coming week is certainly going to be different than what we were expecting before we left for Spring Break. The spread of the Coronavirus will continue to change plans as we move forward, but we will communicate daily to provide as much information as possible.

All school buildings are closed until further notice. We are limiting movement in our community due to the number of people returning from various locations and to comply with the [Governor's executive](#) order for closure of public places.

Initial guidance suggested that school closures would be limited, but as we have seen across the nation, we should anticipate extended school closures. The school district is working on a virtual learning model if we are unable to re-open schools on April 6, 2020. We will share details during the next two weeks as we develop a model to provide education for all students.

We have posted a [Frequently Asked Questions](#) section on our website with information about what to expect during the next couple of weeks.

- Starting on Monday, March 23rd, teachers will begin to work to set up remote communications, so they can work from home. Our expectation is that most of this week will be spent getting schools prepared to do virtual learning if we are unable to return to school on Monday, April 6, 2020.
- On Tuesday, the district plan to distribute meals, the Grab and Go program, will start at five schools. Families should have received communication regarding the program, but if you need additional details, please call the district office at 307-721-4400 or send an email to info@acsd1.org.
- Starting Wednesday, teachers will be contacting families and students either by email or phone to say hello and make a contact with students. You should hear from your child's school this week.
- There is no expectation that students will be doing academic work during the next two weeks, but we will have enrichment activities and ideas posted on our website throughout the week.

This is a time to take care of your families and stay healthy by practicing good hygiene and social distancing. I will be communicating daily with families and employees to lessen what we can of the uncertainty during this time.
