

Chromebook Damage, Theft, Loss and Cost

The educational program for your student includes a Chromebook that will be issued for their use at school and home. While we are pleased to make these powerful tools available to students, we also understand that families are concerned about keeping these tools secure and in good working order. Like textbooks, team uniforms, and other school property issued to students, there is a responsibility to take appropriate care of these valuable resources. The Chromebook is no different, but it does represent an increased cost to the District and liability to students and families. District policies, regulations, and practices require a fine to be levied to cover the repair or replacement cost of District property. With computing devices, like Chromebooks, the cost of damage or loss can be significant. Accidental breakage or damage will be assessed according to the schedule listed below and in the ACSD#1 Chromebook Handbook (exact amounts may vary). Responsibility for repair costs associated with intentional damage or gross negligence will be determined by the ACSD#1 Technology Department.
