Second Grade Supply List



- 1-24 Box Crayons
- 1 Box of Fine Tipped Markers
- 6 BLACK Expo Markers (Dry Erase Marker)
- 1 Box Colored Pencils
- 1 small pencil sharpener that catches shavings
- 48 - #2 Ticonderoga Pencils - **Preferably sharpened at home**
- 1 – Large Pink Eraser
- 1 – Composition Notebook (black & white)
- 2 Large Tissue Boxes
- 2 Pocket Folders
- Utility/Pencil box (approx. 5 3/4" x 8 5/8"x 2 1/2")
- Individual healthy snack for each day. The snacks won't be shared! Students will bring their own snack from home each day. The snacks will not be stored at school.
- Backpack
- Lanyard to keep face mask from touching surfaces

On the first day of school - Students need to arrive at school with the following items in their pencil box:

2 sharpened pencils

1 dry erase marker

eraser

****It is important that students are able to tie their own shoes and zip their own coats this year!**

ALL EXTRA SUPPLIES WILL BE STORED IN THE CLASSROOM TO REPLENISH AS NEEDED. ALL EXTRA PENCILS AND DRY ERASE MARKERS NEED TO BE PLACED IN A LARGE ZIP LOCK BAG, LABELED WITH THE CHILD'S NAME!

Message from the Principal:

Parents, as we head into this new year full of wonder and curiosity, here are some additions to the supply list for all students at Indian Paintbrush.

- A pair of basic earphones (please, not ear buds) with the 3.5mm jack for computer use. Please send these already sealed in a Ziploc type bag with your child's name on it.
- 1-2 water bottles that seal. The hope is that we can get into a routine of taking at least one home a night to be cleaned and still have one ready to go. Please label these with first and last name in as permanent a way as the bottles will let you!

A word about face coverings. We will provide white cloth face masks for your child, about 5 for the year. We would like them cleaned on a routine basis, so we are only handing out 2 to start the year. If you would like to provide a face covering for your student, you are more than welcome to. Please make sure that it would meet dress code standards for content, and, at a minimum, meet a basic cloth requirement for material. Having a clean extra or 2 in their backpack would probably come in handy on some days.
