General Consent and Release

As a University Laboratory School our students receive many opportunities to be involved in innovative learning programs. College of Education professors and students majoring in teacher education are often in our school interacting with U.W. Lab School teaching staff and working with students. Our students receive a great deal of individual attention because of the role the U.W Lab School has in teacher training. All pre-service teachers are required to video tape their lessons with our students. By signing this general consent you are giving your permission to have your child video taped and/or photographed as part of these teaching-learning segments. Preparing your Child for Summer Odyssey

The following is the information you will need to have your child prepared for the summer program.

Once a week, we will have field trips to various locations. Specific Friday field trip information will be sent home each week. At this point, it is hard to know what the mosquito problem will be, but it is advisable that the children wear long pants, long-sleeved shirts, comfortable walking shoes and a hat when we hike Turtle Rock. Sunscreen and water are also a must and bug spray is optional.

Snack time is mid-morning each day. If your child desires a snack, he/she should bring a healthy snack and drink from home.

We will have tie-dyeing on Thursday afternoons with movies and popcorn. Your child must provide his/her own items to tie-dye. These items should be prewashed. With the exception of tie-dye materials, all elective materials and field trip costs are included in your registration.
