Coming into the Building

As families and students return to LHS we are asking that all visitors observe the following safety expectations that we will observe during the year.

- Wash/sanitize hands whenever entering the building.
- Use the multiple hand sanitizing stations throughout the building.
- Sanitize hands when entering and prior to exiting any classroom.
- Wear face coverings and utilize social distancing measures (minimum 6 feet) when possible.

From the LHS Counselors

Our counseling team is still working on filling holes in schedules. If you want a schedule change please go to the counseling office starting on Monday August 31st to fill out a form or schedule an appointment. Students will not be allowed to change their A/B designation of "Hybrid Group". If you are attending

LCCC or UW please get a copy of your schedule to the counseling office. LCCC schedules can found in your “myLCCC” account.

From the Nurse’s Office

There will be significant changes to how students are supported in the Nurse’s Office. Please understand with our heightened safety precautions, students will be sent home if deemed appropriate by the LHS Nurse’s Office. Also, no over the counter as needed medications will be distributed or stored in the Nurses’ Office without prior authorization from our nurses. ***Please complete students’ online registration, so our nurses can best support the medical needs of your child.***

Classroom Based Virtual Instruction (CBVI)

All students should begin seeing CBVI classes appearing in their CANVAS accounts. Our counseling team is verifying what classes are needed to keep students on track, then we can begin placing students in the elective classes that we have created for all students receiving CBVI instruction. Students that would like to attend some classes in person and some classes virtually need to contact Laramie High School so that we can best support the students’ needs and schedule them appropriately.
