From the Nurse's Office

Parents please refer to the attached documents for COVID-19 guidelines, this was developed based on current recommendations from the CDC, WDH, and ACSD1 school nurses. The documents will give you information on when to keep your student home, symptoms that will get your student sent home, and when they can return to school. Please keep in mind this is just a guideline and can change at any time based on new or changing recommendations in accordance with current COVID-19 information.

To minimize school-wide visits to the nurse, please encourage your student to work with their teacher to stay in the classroom for non-emergent and non-illness needs (band-aids, nail clippers, eye drops, etc.). This year we will not be managing over the counter medications (OTC) in the nurse's office due to the potential of these medications masking COVID-19 symptoms. If your student needs an OTC given by the school nurse for a medical diagnosis (migraines, surgery, GERD, etc.), please reach out to us, and we will get you the proper forms and information.

important for us to have current phone numbers, addresses, emergency contacts, and medical information updated yearly.

Thank you all for being so understanding while we try to navigate this pandemic as safely as possible. Keeping sick kids home is the best way for you to help us stay open for face-to-face instruction, activities, and sports.

Vaccine Records:

If you are new to the district or had a vaccine after 7th grade, please get a current immunization record to the school nurse. Per Wyoming State Statute, you have 30 days after the date of enrollment to provide written proof of immunizations or exemptions for your student.

If we do not have this information by September 25, 2020 your student will not be allowed to come to school or participate in sports or activities per Wyoming State law.

From the LHS Counselors

The PSAT is an optional assessment for students. Eligible juniors could use their score to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship. Due to spacing restrictions, we have a limited number of tests available and priority will be given to juniors. The test is offered on Wednesday October 14th and the cost is \$18. To reserve a seat please come by the Counseling Office.

From the Ron Wagner LHS Activities Director

"Friday September 4th is LHS's first home varsity football game at 6pm at Deti Stadium. It is also Senior Night and those festivities will begin at 5:20pm at the stadium. There will be general admission tickets available for community and students for this game as capacity at Deti has been set to 900. It is expected that all people come in and be screened by a worker as well as record their name. It is required of all spectators to wear a face covering to be allowed into the stadium. It is expected that spectators where face coverings the entire time they are at the stadium and family groups should socially distance from others as much as possible.

We will also host a dual girls swimming meet at 4pm versus Campbell County. We will also be celebrating Senior Night beginning just before the meet kicks off. Spectators should have received a link to reserve tickets through Coach Hudson and his staff. Spectators should check in and be screened before entering the facility. It is required that all spectators wear a face covering for entry to the pool area and continue to wear the face covering while inside the pool facility. Families should social distance from one another as well."

Student Expectations

Our biggest priority is the safety of our students. Students and families who choose to attend in-person are also agreeing to follow all school and district safety, health, and

hygiene procedures that have been established in accordance with state and local health officials. This includes the following:

- Students and Staff are required to properly wear face coverings at all times
- Washing/sanitizing hands frequently and whenever entering/exiting classrooms
- Adhere to physical distancing between students (minimum 6 feet whenever possible)
- Avoid congregating in large groups within hallways
- Social (physical) distancing—Facilities and classrooms have been set to maintain 6 feet physical distance, and face coverings are required for students and staff.
