Daily Health Screener:

We are still trying to hit our 90% completion rate for daily health screeners for students. The health screener is accessed through the same parent PowerSchool account that you used to register your student. If you have questions about how to access the screener after setting up a parent PowerSchool account, please call LHS, and someone will help you.

Parent Teacher Conferences: October 21st & 22nd

This year all parent teacher conferences will be held over the phone or on a Zoom Conference Call. Teachers will be reaching out to parents to set up appointments. Students of concern will be prioritized, if you would like to meet with your child's teachers regardless of how they are doing, please reach out to that teacher to schedule an appointment.

We continue to have a lot of students show up for additional support Friday mornings at LHS from 7:55am to 11:25am. This time is specifically designed to help support LHS Students. Please remember if you would like to have your student come to LHS during their virtual days, we can provide a supervised environment as well as have a conversation on what academic support we can provide. From the Nurse's Office

To minimize school-wide visits to the nurse, please encourage your student to work with their teacher to stay in the classroom for non-emergency and non-illness needs (band-aids, nail clippers, eye drops, etc.). We will not be managing over the counter medications (OTC) in the nurse's office. If your student needs an OTC given by the school nurse for a medical diagnosis

(migraines, surgery, GERD, etc.), please reach out to us, and we will get you the proper forms and information.
