ACSD1 illness guidelines for second semester:

Students who have COVID-19 like symptoms (even very mild symptoms) have the following options in order to return to school:

1. Provide a negative PCR COVID test result
2. Provide a doctor's note with an alternative diagnosis
3. Stay home for 10 days

ACSD1 COVID guidelines for second semester:

Students who are positive or a close contact to a COVID-19 positive person will need to stay home while continuing to do schoolwork virtually.

If your student is COVID-19 positive:

- They need to stay home, they cannot participate in school, sports, or activities for 10 days after symptoms started or for 10 days after a positive test if they have no illness symptoms.

If your student is a close contact to a COVID-19 positive person (closer than 6 ft for a total of 15 minutes):

- They need to stay home, they cannot participate in school, sports, or activities for 14 days after the last time they were with the COVID-19 positive person.

- ACSD1 continues to use the recommended 14 days quarantine with no testing out

- ACSD1 will not shorten quarantine based on a doctor's note or negative test.

In the event that your student has already had COVID and gets re-exposed at school, we need the following information for them to not be placed on quarantine:

- Proof of a positive COVID test on file

- Re-exposure would have to fall within 90 days of the positive test results
- We cannot accept antibody testing or a negative test result to get out of quarantine
