Students are welcome to come to LHS for a quiet place to work, because of or lack of supervision if students are not on task or causing a disruption they will be asked to leave for the day. Starting on February 1st we will resume a voluntary structured program to help students in academic core areas.

ACSD1 illness guidelines for second semester:

Students who have COVID-19 like symptoms (even very mild symptoms) need to have/do one of the following options in order to return to school:

1. A negative COVID test
2. A doctor note with an alternative diagnosis
3. Stay home for 10 days

ACSD1 COVID guidelines for second semester:

Students who are positive or a close contact to a COVID-19 positive person will need to stay home while continuing to do school work virtually.

If your student is COVID-19 positive:

- They need to stay home, they cannot participate in school, sports, or activities for 10 days after symptoms started or for 10 days after a positive test if they have no illness symptoms.

If your student is a close contact to a COVID-19 positive person (closer than 6 ft for a total of 15 minutes):

- They need to stay home, they cannot participate in school, sports, or activities for 14 days after the last time they were with the COVID-19 positive person.
- ACSD1 continues to use the recommended 14 days quarantine with no testing out
- ACSD1 will not shorten quarantine based on a doctor's note or negative test.

CBVI student that weren't able to complete their ELA, Math, and/or Writing assessments are invited to attend the WY-TOPP make-up session this Friday, January 22nd at 8:15AM in the LHS cafeteria. **CBVI Students are asked to bring their school issued computer to take their assessments.**

This week, in-person students should have completed their WY-TOPP math assessment. In-person students that weren't able to take or finish their WY-TOPP math assessment are invited to attend the WY-TOPP make-up session this Friday, January 22nd at 8:15AM in the LHS cafeteria. **In-person students are asked to bring their school issued computer to take their assessment.**

STUDENTS ARE ASKED TO BRING THEIR SCHOOL ISSUED COMPUTER JANUARY 25th-28th TO COMPLETE THE LANGUAGE ARTS WY-TOPP ASSESSMENTS. A second WY-TOPP make-up session will take place in the LHS cafeteria at 8:15AM on Friday, January 29th.
