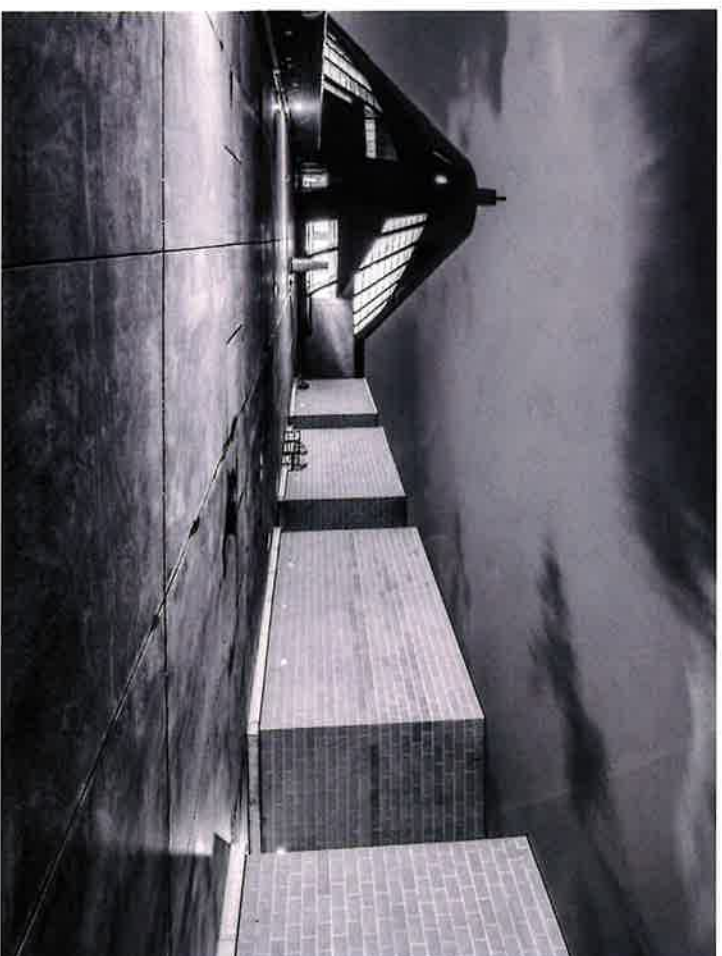

ANN SIMPSON ARTMOBILE VIRTUAL EXPERIENCES

The Ann Simpson Artmobile Program is now offering virtual experiences for Albany County schools. Through this free program, students explore images from the Artmobile exhibition *At Work and At Play*. The content is interdisciplinary with strong connections to social studies and language arts. Students look closely at artworks, hone their

critical thinking skills, and develop evidence-based interpretations with the support of the Artmobile Educator and their peers. This activity enables students to consider the roles of work and play in the development of community, society, culture, and identity. Teachers may book an additional session for a hands-on project where students draw on their experiences and bring value to the many ways they contribute to family, community, and society; make meaningful connections with others; and enrich and sustain community life--through work and play.

AFTERSCHOOL ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

Students in 2nd grade may participate in a free after-school program at the Art Museum called *Imagine Learning from the Masters*. This program is made possible through a partnership with Albany County School District #1 and uses original artwork in the UW Art Museum to enhance students' art, writing, thinking and speaking skills. Students will have the opportunity to sign up for the program through their elementary school. Each program meets for one 3-day virtual session (Tuesday -Thursday) with two options of dates to choose from. Each session is limited to 15 students, first come, first serve and will run from 3:45-5:00 p.m. on Zoom.

ASE follows the Art Museum's model of inquiry: observe, question, explore, create and reflect. These dynamic classes engage students in essential learning activities in ways that are fun and creative. They will work with museum educators on writing and art skills, using art on view as a starting point for their own ideas and creative processes.
