# Reminders

## *Health Guidelines*

Parents, students, and staff need to complete the Daily Health Screener consistently. Students or staff who have COVID-19 like symptoms must have a negative PCR test, and be symptom free for 24 hours before they can return to school. OR, they must remain in isolation or quarantine for 10 days before returning to school.

If you are in need of a test, you can order a [Free COVID-19 Test Kit](#) from the Wyoming Department of Health. The school also has extra tests that we can send home for your child.

With basketball in full swing, we continue to adhere to the guidelines set by WHSAA and the health department. Currently we have to limit the number of spectators at basketball games for both junior high boys and high school games. At this time there is no general admission to games. Spectators will be limited to players' families. Event staff will monitor admittance at the door and assist with any questions. Face coverings must be worn throughout the duration of games. We thank you in advance for your cooperation with these guidelines.
