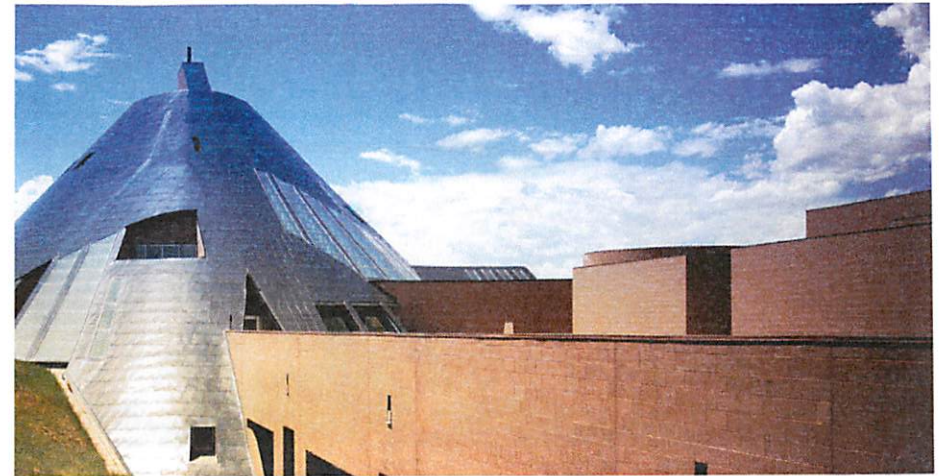

## AFTERSCHOOL ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

Laramie elementary students in grades 1-3 can participate in Learning from the Masters, a free afterschool program at the UW Art Museum.

These dynamic classes engage students in essential learning activities through fun and creative approaches. Each visit follows the museum's model of inquiry: observe, question, explore, create and reflect. During the series, participants will work with teaching artists, writers and a master teacher on a variety of creative skills, using art on exhibit as a starting point to explore their own ideas and creative processes.

To sign up, contact your elementary art educator. Each elementary school is limited to 30 students. Sessions run Monday - Thursday, 3:30 - 4:45 pm for a total of seven visits per school. See schedule for detailed dates. Students are bused from their elementary school to the Art Museum and then home through bus rentals from ASCD. Pick up at the Art Museum is also possible by a prearranged guardian.
