Student Identification Bus Cards (Zpass)

As part of our continued effort to provide unparalleled student safety, the Albany County School District 1 Transportation Department requires all students who ride a bus to carry with them a bus ID card. The ID card helps ensure students are using the correct bus stop location and riding the correct bus. When properly used it provides information on when and where a student entered or exited a school bus as well as valuable information in case of an emergency.

The student ID card system, called “Zpass”, utilizes GPS technology embedded in the student’s identification card. When a student enters or exits the bus, they swipe their ID card near a scanner located on the dash of the school bus. Each time the student swipes their card, Zpass will record the student name, time of the swipe, and the geographic location of the bus. This information will be immediately uploaded and available to the transportation staff to track student ridership. The card does not track the student but rather tracks the location of bus and when the student entered or exited the bus.
