Hello Slade Families!

To get your child(ren) started learning this year, we first need you to update your child(ren)'s information in PowerSchool. We must have this information updated to ensure access to the Health Screener Application you must complete each morning and to checkout a Chromebook for in person/virtual use. If you need assistance, please call Mrs. Burns at 721-4446. Please log into your PowerSchool account to:

1. Update all information in the online registration system of PowerSchool
2. Read, agree, and sign off on the terms in the "Agreements Section". The Agreements are:
 - Computer/Internet Permission
 - Parent Permission for Student Email
 - Chromebook Agreement
 - Field Trip Permission
 - Student Name/Photo Release
 - Release of Information - Family Educational Rights & Privacy Act (FERPA)

Daily Health Screener:



Every morning before arriving on school grounds, families must complete the HealthEd screener for each child attending school. The HealthEd Check is found in your child's PowerSchool account. To access the HealthEd screener:

1. Log into PowerSchool Parent Account
2. On the left-hand side of the screen there is a HealthEd Check icon.
3. Click on the icon to begin the health screener questionnaire.
4. Once you have answered the questions click submit.
5. If an alert appears, please call the school before sending your child to school. If no alert appears, you are ready to enter the building.

You must complete this screener for each child. Please be on the lookout for an email from the school district for more information.

Arrival and Departure from School:

Our drop-off and pick-up time will look a lot different this year as we extend these times to ensure social distancing and safety protocols. The biggest change is the number of families dropping kids off and picking them up from school each day. In order to create a system that runs smoothly, we are working to change the traffic flow around the school by providing more areas for families to use during these times.

We are attempting to have buses and daycare vans arrive by 8:05 am and depart by 2:55 pm. This should open us space around our school for families to drop-off children between 8:05-8:20 am and pick-up between 2:55-3:05 pm. As always, please be mindful of the buses and where they park by avoiding parking in those areas. Please look for new signage to mark these areas. Also, be on high alert for more students accessing cars and walking or riding bikes home.

If your child is in Kindergarten, please use the west side of the school on 11th Street. This is the side with the flag pole.

If your child is in 1st – 5th grade, please utilize the south side of the school on Sully Street along the playground area.

If your child is in the DLI program or preschool, your drop-off/pick-up area is on the North side of the school on Baker Street.
